This funding will be used to


- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- 60% of students achieving a C or higher in English at the end of each semester, apart from those on endorsed ICP's.
- 25% of students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science at the end of each Semester.

Our initiatives include

- Purchase additional teaching staff to run an intervention and extension program for students.
- Continue to develop and implement literacy and numeracy programs by investing in specialist literacy/numeracy teacher aides.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Staffing \$11,730. Purchase a teacher 0.2 FTE to run an intervention and extension program once per week primarily focusing on reading / numeracy as a form of problem solving and higher order thinking.
